CV: Input (with attenuator) for the control voltage for positive or inverted amplification of the signal at the "In" input. The amount of amplification is indicated with a two-color LED (yellow = positive, red = inverted).

Mod: Control voltage input for modulating the control voltage present at the "CV" input. At -5V the control voltage is completely blocked, at +5V or without a patch cable in the switch socket it is fully used.

In: Inputs for an audio signal or a control voltage. The signal can be amplified, weakened or inverted with the module.

The inputs to the right have the same functions for the second sub-module.
